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Objective

To help support students in their continued education and support of their interests.

Description

The MDHMA will designate \$250.00 annually towards the Youth Scholarship Fund to award it each year. MDHMA reserves the right to adjust the grant amount on an annual basis, depending on the needs of the youth and available funding.

Criteria

Applicant or sponsor must be a member of the Missouri Draft Horse & Mule Association.

Must be between the ages of 12 - 27. Must be a dependent or a full-time student.

Applicant, their family or sponsor must have participated in one MDHMA function in the year they apply. Example: farm days, seminar, booth at sales, annual meeting, etc.....

(for 2011, your 2010 participation will be recognized).

Applications for grant must be submitted to MDHMA's Secretary/Treasurer by the designated due date.

Applications must be received no later than March 1st the first year the youth fund is implemented (2010) and every year thereafter.

Review Process

A committee consisting of MDHMA's President and two other members will review the applications

received and will determine which applicant will receive the grant. Notification

The recipient of our Youth Grant will be announced at our annual meeting. If the recipient is not present, they will be notified after the function by phone or e-mail.

Pay Out Process

A check, issued by the Secretary Treasurer will be made directly to the recipient within 30 days of the annual meeting.
